Craig W. Czarsty, MD, Chair-Elect

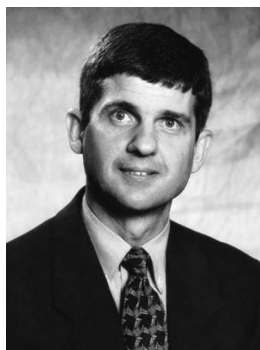
