2021 was the 34th year of print and 19th year of online publication of the *Journal of the American Board of Family Medicine (JABFM)*. Here we provide our annual report of articles published in 2021 that were of greatest interest to our readers.

Table 1 shows the 10 most frequently read articles in 2021 from Volume 34. Once again, original research proves to be the most-read type of article. In Table 2, we provide the 10 most frequently
