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## Opioids: Family Medicine Perspectives and Solutions

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### OVERVIEW

The *Journal of the American Board of Family Medicine* invites papers exploring family medicine perspective and solutions for opioid medication management. The accepted papers will be published in an upcoming special theme issue.

### TOPICS

The following research topics are of high priority for this theme issue:

- Health system factors and interventions that contribute to successful opioid medication management and improved patient outcomes. This could include alternate methods of pain control, decision-support tools, methods that change patient perceptions of opioids and opioid abuse, and family interventions.
- Methods for primary care offices to address the psycho-social-behavioral factors that influence opioid abuse.
- The cost of opioid care in primary care offices.
- The association of the provision of opioid care to clinician and staff career burnout or satisfaction.
- Novel population-based interventions addressing opioid addiction.
- Patient-oriented interventions designed to educate and alter patient perceptions about opioids and opioid use.
