Well-being of the Health Care Team

OVERVIEW

The *Journal of the American Board of Family Medicine* invites papers exploring the well-being of members of the health care team including work factors that are correlated with well-being, interventions to address well-being, and outcomes of work-related stress and burnout. The accepted papers will be published in an upcoming special theme issue.

TOPICS

The following research topics are of high priority for this theme issue:

- Work-place factors that contribute to, or protect against, health care team member burnout.
- Generational differences in beliefs and expectations regarding the well-being of members of the health care team.
- Interventional initiatives designed to maintain, or build, resilience among health care team members.
- Patient-oriented outcomes impacted by health care team member burnout.
- Interventional initiatives designed to promote recovery of health care team members who are identified as burnt out or otherwise not well.
- The cost of health care team member burnout and/or mental health conditions.
